The Summer Series

A series of teaching sessions designed for the entry level junior golfer. Recommended for juniors new to the sport or with 1 to 3 years of experience.

The Summer Junior Golf Program is offered as an introduction to golf for juniors ages 5-17. The schedule will include a series of weekly group sessions that will cover the full swing, putting, chipping, pitching, sand play, course management and the rules of golf. At the completion of the series, we will conduct a Skills Challenge.

Our mission is to introduce juniors to the game of golf and provide them with the basic skills to learn how to play on the course. Juniors will be placed into groups based on their age and/or current skill level. Clinics will be held each week on either Tuesdays or Thursdays, depending on your age.

We do request that 5 to 7-year-olds be accompanied by an adult (one adult for every 2 kids). If you have clubs, even if just one, bring them. If you do not have club, we will have some that you may borrow.
